1. Name of the firm	Kerala State Beverages (Manufacturing & Marketing) Corporation Limited
2. Name of Post	Driver Grade II
3. Scale of Pay	Rs.3050-5230/- (Pre-revised)
4. Number of vacancies	6 (Six)

**NOTE :** (i) The above vacancies are now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in pursuance of this Notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of One year and a maximum period of Three years provided that the list will not continue to be in force if a new Ranked List after the minimum period of One year is published. Candidates will be advised against the vacancies shown above and for all the vacancies reported during the period of pendency of the Ranked list.

(ii) The Kerala Public Service Commission shall have the power to cancel the advice for appointment of any candidates to the above post, if it is subsequently found that such advice was made under some mistake. On such cancellation the appointing authority shall terminate the service of candidate, provided that, the cancellation of advice for appointment by the Commission and subsequent termination of service of the candidate by the appointing authority shall be made with in the period of probation or 240 days from the date of joining duty whichever is earlier.

5. Method of Appointment	:	Direct Recruitment
6. Age Limit	:	Must have completed 18 (Eighteen) years and must not have completed 35 (Thirty five) years of age as on 01.01.2008 with usual relaxation to SC/ST/OBC

**NOTE** (i) The provisional and daily wage workers who are continuing in Kerala State Beverages Corporation for more than 6 months will be given age relaxation to the extent of their length of service subject to the

conditions that the maximum age limit shall in no case exceed 50 (Fifty) years. But the regular employees of the concern are not eligible for the above concession for further appointment. The provisional and daily wage workers should obtain a certificate showing the period of their provisional service in the concern and shall produce the same as and when required by the Commission. It would also be clearly specified in the certificate that they were not working in the regular service of the concern.

**7. Qualifications :-**

1) Pass in Standard IV

2) Must possess Motor Driving Licence of at least 3 years standing with endorsement to drive Light and Heavy Motor Vehicles and Drivers' Badge. Driving License issued after 16.01.1979 should have separate endorsement for driving Heavy Duty Goods Vehicle and Heavy Duty Passenger Vehicles. The licence should be valid at the time of submitting the application, date of Written Test and Practical Test.

3) Proficiency in driving Heavy Motor Vehicles (To be proved at a Practical Test to be conducted by PSC.)

4) Should be medically fit as per the standards specified below :

(a) Ear, hearing should be perfect.

(b) Eye, Distant Vision : 6/6 Snellen

Near Vision : 0.5 Snellen

Colour Vision : Normal

Night Blindness : Nil

(c) Muscles and Joints :

No Paralysis and all joints with free movement

(d) Nervous System :

Perfectly normal, should be free from any infectious diseases.

**Note: (1)** The Medical Certificate (in original) issued in the prescribed form by a Medical Officer not below the rank of a Civil Surgeon showing the above details must be produced as and when called for by the Commission

**Note (2)** Physically Handicapped persons are not eligible to apply.

8. The applications can be submitted by on-line facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission viz. [www.kerala.psc.org](http://www.kerala.psc.org). No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further

enquiries/correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website will be summarily rejected.

Candidates are allowed to submit applications either by on-line or in the conventional application form

9. Application Form

The cost of application form is Rs.10/- (Rupees Ten only). The cost of application form for Scheduled Caste/Scheduled Tribe candidates of the State of Kerala is Rs.5/- (Rupees Five only)

The application forms can be obtained from the post offices inside the state and offices of the Kerala Public Service Commission. The application should be filled up in accordance with the direction contained in the information brochure supplied along with the application form. Documents to prove qualification, community, age, experience etc. have to be produced as and when called for. No copies of documents should be attached with the application. Applications should be submitted in the form devised and printed by the Kerala Public Service Commission and applications otherwise submitted will be summarily rejected.
