1. Department : **Public Works (Administration)**

4. Number of vacancies : 50 (Fifty)

Note: - The list of selected candidates published by the Commission shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year and a maximum period of three years provided that the said list will not continue to be in force if a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year is published. Recruitment will be made for the above vacancies and also for the vacancies reported for Special Recruitment from Scheduled Tribes during the pendency of the list.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment (from among Scheduled Tribes only)

Note:- Applications received from candidates other than Scheduled Tribe candidates will be rejected. Individual communications regarding the rejection of their applications for the above reason will not be issued.

6. Age Limit : Should have completed 21(Twenty One) years and should not have completed 40 (Forty) years as on 01.01.2008 (No other age relaxation will be allowed).

Note: - In the absence of qualified candidates within the age limit the upper age limit shall be relaxed upto 50 years. But in no case the maximum age shall exceed 50 (Fifty) years.

7. Qualifications:-

B.Sc / B.Tech Degree in Engineering (Civil) of the Kerala University.

OR

B.E Degree (Civil) of the Madras University or any other qualification recognized as equivalent thereto.

OR

Associate membership of the Institution of Engineers (India) in Civil Engineering or any other Diploma recognized as equivalent thereto

OR

Pass in Section 'A' and 'B' of Associate membership Examination of the Institute of Engineers India in Civil Engineering .

Liability to serve to the Defence Service:

Persons appointed to the post shall be liable not withstanding that at the time of requisition of their service they are holding higher appointments to serve for a minimum period of 4 (Four) years (including the period spent on training) in the Defence Service or on assignments relating to Defence efforts anywhere in India or abroad if so required. The liability to serve in the Defence service shall be limited to the first 10 (Ten) years of service and shall not ordinarily apply to persons above 40 (Forty) years of age.

9. The application should be submitted only through on-line facility provided in the website of the Kerala Public Service Commission. Detailed instructions regarding the submission of applications are available in the website of Kerala Public Service Commission viz. www.keralapsc.org. No application fee is required. The barcode number in the application form shall be quoted in all further enquiries/ correspondence. Documents to prove qualification, age and community have to be produced as and when called for. Applications which are submitted not in accordance with the instructions given in the website and other than through on-line will be summarily rejected.

10. Paragraphs two, three and twenty seven (Except the conditions laid down in the Rule 3 (C) of Part II of the Kerala State and Subordinate Services Rules) are not applicable to this selection.

11. Appointments are made subject to the rank secured in the ranked list of candidates prepared in pursuance of this notification subject to

the conditions laid down in G.O.(P) No.25/ 94/ GAD dated 22.01.1994 allowing special reservations to Scheduled Tribes in accordance with the procedures made for this purpose from time to time and subject to the rules under sections 3 (C) , 17 (a), 17 (b) of Part II of Kerala State and Subordinate Service Rules, 1958.
