1. Department : Education (Schools for Physically Handicapped)
2. Name of post : Assistant Teacher (Visually Impaired)
3. Scale of pay : Rs.8390 – 13270/-
4. Number of vacancies : 9 (Nine)

The number of vacancies shown above is subjected to change depending on the annual fixation of staff by the Education Department. The selection in pursuance of this notification will be made on statewide basis.

The above vacancies are now in existence. The list of selected candidates published by the Commission in response to this notification shall remain in force for a minimum period of one year provided that the said list will continue to be in force till the publication of a new list after the expiry of the minimum period of one year or till the expiry of three years whichever is earlier. Candidates will be advised from the said list against the vacancy noted above and the vacancies that may be reported to the Commission in writing during the currency of the list.

5. Method of appointment : Direct Recruitment

6. Age: 18-40. Only candidates born between 2.1.1970 and 1.1.1992 (both dates included) are eligible to apply for this post. Other Backward Communities and SC/ST candidates are eligible for usual age relaxation.

(For conditions regarding other age relaxation please see para 2 of the General Conditions).

Note:- Departmental candidates shall be given relaxation from upper age limit to the extent of their approved service in the Department.

7. Qualifications:

1. Pass in SSLC or its equivalent.
2. T.T.C and
3. Lower certificate/Junior Diploma in Teaching the Blind.

Note:- (i) Preference within the meaning of G.O (M.S)No.50/70/PD dated 12.2.70 will be given to candidates who possess Higher Diploma/Higher Certificate in teaching the blind.

(ii) Blind persons shall be exempted from possessing TTC qualification provided they possess the Special Training Certificate in teaching the blind issued by a recognized Institution.

(iii) Higher Diploma/Higher Certificate, Junior Diploma/Lower Certificate in teaching the Blind issued by Institution recognized by the State Government/Central Government/Universities or Board of Examinations in India and those issued by foreign countries shall be considered as equivalent to Higher Diploma/Higher Certificate, Junior Diploma/Lower Certificate issued by this Government respectively.

Special Concession regarding appointment:

(1) Preference will be given as laid down in the G.O (MS)No.9/78/General Edn. Dated 21.1.1978 to wives of Jawans in the matter of recruitment as Teachers if they possess the prescribed qualifications, subject to the rules of reservation.

Soldiers in active service and those working in base establishments are included under the terms of Jawans. Wife of Jawan should note on the application that they are wives of Jawans. Such candidates should produce proper certificates (true copies) from the Commanding Officers stating the names, Military Rank and Military address of their Husbands as and when called for by the Commission. (G.O.M.S. No.509/64/Edn. Dated 19.9.64, G.O (MS) No. 614/65/Edn. Dated 9.11.1965 and G.O (MS)No.243/66/Edn. Dated 27.5.1966.

(2) First Class Scouts and Guides will be given preference in the matter of appointment as Teachers.
(G.O (MS)No.122/75/G.Edn. dated 27.5.1975).

Note: The candidates who claim concessions in the view of any of the above reasons should state the facts in the relevant column of the application.
